

Notice of Location.

Notice is hereby given that we the undersigned
 Citizens of the United States Claim fifteen
 hundred feet linear measure, on this lode or vein
 of gold or silver bearing quartz, commencing
 and this notice and monument and running
 easterly therefrom along the line of the lode
 750 feet to a stake marked East end center
 and easterly along the line of said lode
 a distance of 750 feet to a stake marked
 East end center Stake, with the dips Spurs
 and angles of said lode. Together with
 the surface ground on each side of said
 lode, bounded and described as follows
 to wit: Commencing at the Stake last named
 and running northerly therefrom at a
 right angle with the general direction of
 said lode three hundred feet to a Stake
 marked North corner Stake; thence at right
 angle Westerly seven hundred and fifty
