Notice is hereby given that I,
The undersigned, Citizens of the
United States, claim fifteen hundred
feet linear measure, on this lode or
vein of gold or silver bearing quartz,
commencing at this notice or monu-
ment and running Eastward therefrom
along the line of the lode 1400 feet to
a stake marked East end center
stake, and 100 along the line of said
lode a distance of 1500 feet to a stake
marked West end center stake, with
the dips, pines and angles of said
lode, together with the surface ground
on each side of said lode, bounded
