Notice is hereby given that We the  
 undersigned, citizens of the United  
 States, claim fifteen hundred feet  
 linear measure on the lode or vein  
 of gold or silver bearing quartz,  
 commencing at this notice and  
 monument and running easterly  
 therefrom along the line of the lode  
 50 feet to a stake marked east  
 end center stake, and westerly along  
 the line of said lode a distance of  
 1450 feet to a stake marked West  
 end center stake, with the dip, spurs
