

Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned citizen of the United States claiming claim hundred feet linear measure on this lode or vein of gold or silver bearing quartz, commencing at this place and running and running Westward therefrom along the line of the lode to the center of Boulder Creek 50 feet and to center of Ruby Falls on Boulder Creek and Eastward along the line of said lode a distance of 1500 feet to a stake marked East end center stake, with the dip, spurs and angles of said lode, together with the surface ground on each side of said lode, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the stake last named and running South therefrom at a right angle with the general direction of said lode three hundred feet to a stake marked E. E. corner stake; thence at a right angle Westward seven hundred and fifty feet to a stake marked South side center stake; thence Westward seven hundred and fifty feet to a stake marked S. W. corner stake; thence at a right angle Northward, along Boulder Creek 600 feet to a stake marked N. W. corner stake; thence at a right angle Eastward seven hundred and fifty feet to a stake marked

 fifty feet to a stake marked
 N. E. corner stake; Thence at a
 right angle Southerly three
 hundred feet to place of begin-

 Claim and Lode, and is loca-
 ted under and by virtue of the
 Mining Laws of the Congress of
 the United States and is situa-
 ted about 13 miles from Mount
 Adams in Skamania County
