Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that I the
undersigned Citizen of the
United States claim fifteen
hundred feet linear measure
on this lode or vein of gold or
silver bearing quartz, commu-
encing at this notice and monu-
-ment and running Westwardly
therefrom along the line of the
lode 1500 to a stake marked West
end center stake, and Eastwardly
along the line of said lode a
distance of 1500 feet, to a stake
marked East end center stake
with the dips, spurs and angles
of said lode together with the sur-
-face ground on each side of said
lode, bounded and described
as follows, to-wit: Commencing
