

## Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that I, the  
 undersigned citizen of the United  
 States claim fifteen hundred feet  
 linear measure, on this lode or  
 vein of gold or silver bearing quartz  
 commencing at this notice and  
 monument and running East-  
 -tly therefrom along the line of  
 the lode 150 feet to a stake mark-  
 -ed East end center stake and  
 West along the line of said lode  
 a distance of 150 feet to a stake  
 West end center stake, with the  
 dips spurs and angles of the said  
 lode together with the surface  
 ground on each side of said  
 lode, bounded and described  
 as follows, to-wit: Commencing
