Take notice that the undersigned has located and filed for record with the County Clerk a Water right. Said Water right is located on Moos Creek a tributary to the Wild White Salmon (Kamania @ Wash of 26 1/2 N 90 W 20 M). Said Water right extends from the mouth of Moos Creek 1/2 300 feet above a dam built for the purpose to control sufficient water enough to fill the dam at any time to be used for power to drive a water wheel for a Shingle Mill and for irrigation purposes.
