

Location Notice

Notice is hereby that the undersigned in compliance with the requirements of the Revised Statutes of the United States has this day located and claims fifteen hundred feet linear feet along the course of this lead lode or vein of mineral bearing quartz and three hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said lead lode or vein together with all mineral deposits contained therein and all timber growing within the limits of said claim and all water and water privileges thereon or appurtenant thereto situate in the St. Helens Mining district County of Stannanish Wash and more particularly described as follows to wit:
