Notice is hereby given that I claim the water now running and being in "Mill Creek" to the extent of one cubic foot of water to one second of time, for the purpose of "Flushing", the same to be taken from the said creek when it flows through the land now owned by Mrs. Elizabeth Fields, and more particularly described by an Alder tree marked "X" and carried by ditch and flume in a North Easterly direction through the said land of Mrs. C. Fields; thence through the land formerly claimed by one Josin, thence in the same direction through the land now owned by F. G. Inman, and intersecting a small lake known as Jordan Lake thence running in a South Easterly direction to the Columbia River.
