

Notice of Location of Placer Claim

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizens of the United States over the age of twenty-one years, John H. Foyt, J. W. Fricke, A. F. Caldwell and John Gordon as a company, did on the 12 day of May 1894, locate a "Placer claim" of 40 acres, situate in the County of Kamama of Washington and more particularly described as follows: Lying about two and one half (2 1/2) miles above cabin of Joseph Masters on the North side of Lewis River and about three quarters of a mile below the homestead claim of Peterson, and being the only large bar in that neighborhood or vicinity, on the North side of said Lewis River, and that we intend to hold and work said above described claim according to the local laws or regulations, and the customs and rules of miners and mining statutes and laws of the United States.
