Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned, in compliance with the requirements of the revised Statutes of the United States, has this day located and claim fifteen hundred linear feet along the course of this lead lode or vein of Mineral-bearing quartz, and three hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said lead lode or vein, together with all mineral deposits contained therein, and all timber growing within the limits of said claim and all water and water privilege thereon or appurtenant thereto, situated in the Not Known Mining District, County of Skamania and State of Wash, ington, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Commencing at Discovery near a fall on a small stream which flows from the divide between the termination of the North Fork of the Toulle River and middle fork of the Toulle River emptying into a lake at the base of Mt. St. Helen on its North East side and extending fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a Northerly direction and 500 feet on each side of the middle of said vein and shall be known as the Tammam Mine.
