

Location Notice of Laramie & J. H. Copley

Notice is hereby given, That the undersigned, in compliance with the requirements of the Revised Statutes of the United States, have this day located and claim fifteen hundred linear feet along the course of the lead lode or vein of mineral bearing quartz, and three hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said lead lode or vein, together with all mineral deposits contained therein, and all timber growing within the limits of said claim, and all water and water privileges thereon or appurtenant thereto, situated in the Mining District of Laramie and State of Wyoming, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:
