

Location Notice of Copley and Lammiman

Notice is hereby given, That the undersigned, in compliance with the requirements of the Revised Statutes of the United States have this day located and claim fifteen hundred linear feet along the course of the lead, lode or vein of mineral-bearing quartz, and three hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said lead, lode or vein, together with all mineral deposits contained therein, and all timber growing within the limits of said claim, and all water and water privileges thereon or appurtenant thereto, situate in the --- mining District, County of Skamania and State of Washington and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Commencing at discovery on a small stream which flows into the North fork of the Toulce river near its termination, from its south side, and extends fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a northerly direction and three hundred (300) feet on each side of the center of said vein, and shall be known as the Lammiman mine
