

Location notice of Dr. U. M. Tammann

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, in compliance with the requirements of the Revised Statutes of the United States, has this day located and claim fifteen hundred feet along the course of this lead, lode or vein of mineral bearing quartz and three hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said lead, lode or vein, together with all mineral deposits contained therein, and all timber growing within the limits of said claim, and all water and water privileges thereon or appurtenant thereto, situate in the not known, Mining District, County of Hamamra and State of Pennsylvania and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Commencing at discovery at the foot of a fall of about one hundred feet on a south terminal branch of the North Fork of the Toudle River. And extends fifteen hundred feet in a north westerly direction and three hundred feet on each side of the middle of said vein & crosses the Cato Mary Mine &c. Etc. &c. & extends the Copley mine, and shall be known as the Little Octavia mine.
