

Location Notice

Notice is hereby given, that the undersigned, in compliance with the requirements of the Revised Statutes of the United States, has this day located and claim fifteen hundred linear feet along the course of the lead, lode or vein of mineral-bearing quartz, and three hundred feet in width on each side of the middle of said lead, lode or vein, together with all mineral deposits contained therein, and all timber growing within the limits of said claim, and all waters and water privileges theron or affluents thereof, situated in the Post known Mining District, County of Skamania and State of Washington and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at discovery at the foot of a fall of about 100 feet on a terminal branch of the North Fork of the Middle river and extends sixteen hundred feet up a South Easterly direction and three hundred feet on each side of the middle of said vein and extends the Little Octavia mine and shall be known as the Octavia mine.
