

Notice of Location. = M. C. Stimpson. Ed. Cummings

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter six (6) of Title Thirty-two (32) of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the Local customs, laws and regulations have located fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet, with surface ground six hundred (600) feet in width, on the Spirit Lake Gold situated in St. Helens Mining District Skamania County, Washington, and described as follows: Beginning at a stone monument situated in the bed of Deer Creek (so called) at a point three hundred and eighty five (385) feet from the mouth of said Deer Creek on the West shore of the North East arm of Spirit Lake, from which stone monument a larch tree three (3) feet diam. and thirty-six and one half ($36\frac{1}{2}$) feet distant bears South six degrees (6°) East and a hundred tree two (2) feet diam. and thirty five (35) feet distant bears North twenty degrees (20°) East. Said stone monument being the point of discovery: Thence running South sixty-five degrees (65°) West fifteen hundred (1500) feet to a larch tree two (2) feet in diam. and blazed on four sides. Also beginning at the above described stone monument and running thence North 25° West 300 ft to N.E. Corner of claim, thence South 65° West 1500 ft. to N.W. corner of claim, thence South 25° East 600 ft. to S.W. corner of claim, thence North 65° East 1500

feet to S. E corner of claim. thence
North 25° W 300 feet to the place of
