Notice of Location under U.S.
laws of the Lake Camp Quartz mine

ground discovered and located

Beginning at a stone monument
situated in the bed of Deer Creek
so called at a point 385 ft from
the mouth of said Deer Creek on the
west shore of the N.E. arm of Spirit
Lake from such monument a Larch
tree 5 ft in diameter and 36 1/2 ft distant
bearing S 6° E and a Lambrock tree
2 ft in diameter and 35 ft distant
bearing North 20° East said stone
monument being point of discovery
thence North 65° E 1500 ft to a
center tree on Right Bank of Oconer
Creek blozed on 4 sides with 4
corners set.
