Description beginning at a Larch tree flayed on 4 sides 12 inches in diameter with notice of location written on one side said flayed tree being situated on the right-hand bank of a tributary of Spirit Lake and $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles north and a little east of where Oconee creek flows into Spirit Lake, County of Skumawia State of Washington from said tree North 44° West - 1500 to a center tree 4 ft in diameter flayed on 4 sides marked N. center tree with 4 corners trees established
