

Location Notice of S. P. White

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned have this day located 1500 linear feet on the ledge or lode as a quartz mining claim, described as follows: to-wit: 1500 feet along lead in a southeasterly direction from this notice and 200 feet southward and 200 feet northward from center of this ledge and notice.

Situated as follows: About 150 yards from head of Blue Bird Creek, a tributary of main Cheyenne River and east of Bald Mountain about one mile, and the head of said Blue Bird Creek east and at the foot of Kuckleberry Butte, next to upper falls of said creek, below mine very rough and steep for $\frac{3}{4}$ mile. This claim to be known as the "Blue Bird" quartz mining claim.
