Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that I the undersigned
Citizen of the United States claim fifteen
hundred feet linear measure on this
vein or lode of Gold or Silver bearing
quartz. Commencing at this notice and
monument and running West therefrom
along the line of said lode 100 feet to
a stake marked West end center stake,
and East along the line of said lode a
distance of 1500 feet to a stake marked
