Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that we the under-
signed Citizens of the United States claim
fifteen hundred feet Linear Measure
on this lode or vein of Gold or Silver being
quartz, commencing at this notice and
monument and running easterly
therefrom along the line of the lode 1500 feet
to a stake marked east end center stake
and westerly along the line of said lode
a distance of 1500 feet to a stake marked
west end center stake, with the
dips spurs and angles of said lode
together with the surface ground on
each side of said lode bounded
and described as follows to-wit:

Commencing at the stake last named and running Northern therefrom at a right angle with the general direction of said lode three hundred feet to a stake marked North West Corner Stake; thence at right angles Easterly seven hundred and fifty feet to a stake marked North East Corner Stake; thence at right angle Southern three hundred feet to a stake marked East end center stake; thence Southern 300 feet to a stake marked S. & E.
