

Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that J. Gast Severett the undersigned citizen of the United States claims fifteen hundred feet linear measure on the lode or vein of gold or silver bearing quartz commencing at this Notice and monument and running Easterly therefrom along the line of the lode 1500 feet to a Stake marked East end center Stake, and Westerly along the line of said lode a distance of 1500 feet to a Stake marked West end center Stake with the dips, spurs, and angles of said lode together with the surface ground on each side of said lode bounded and described as follows, to wit: commencing at the stake last named and running Southerly therefrom at a right angle with the general direction of said lode three hundred feet to a stake marked South west corner Stake; thence at a right angle East seven hundred and fifty feet to a stake marked South side center Stake; thence East seven hundred and fifty feet to a stake marked Southeast corner Stake; thence at a right angle North three hundred feet to a stake marked East end center Stake; thence North three hundred feet to a stake marked Northeast corner Stake; thence at a right angle West seven hundred and fifty feet to a stake marked North side center Stake; thence West seven hundred and fifty feet to a stake marked North West corner Stake; thence at a right angle South three hundred feet to place of beginning. 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Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned, citizen of the United States, claim fifteen hundred feet linear measure on this lode or vein of gold or silver bearing quartz, commencing at this notice and monument and running Westerly therefrom along the line of the lode 1500 feet to a stake marked West end center Stake, and Easterly along the line of said lode a distance of 1500 feet to a stake marked East end center Stake, with the dips, spurs and angles of said lode, together with the surface ground on each side of said lode, bounded and described as follows, to wit: commencing at the stake last named and running South therefrom at a right angle with the general direction of said lode three hundred feet to a stake marked Southeast corner Stake; thence at right angle west, seven hundred and fifty feet to a stake marked South side center Stake; thence west 750 feet to a stake marked South west corner
