### Notice of Location

Notice is hereby Given That we the undersigned, Citizens of the United States Claim fifteen hundred feet linear measure on this lode or vein of Gold or Silver bearing quartz. Commencing at this notice and monument and running west westerly therefrom along the line of the lode 75 feet to a Stake marked west end center Stake and east along the line of said lode a distance of 1425 feet to a Stake marked East end center Stake, with the dips, spurs and angles of said lode.
