

Know all men by these presents that I, R. A. Hill the party of the first part for and in consideration of One dollar and the exchange of Seven hundred and fifty feet of the "Souveneir" Mining quartz lode, being and situated on the North side of Blue Bird Creek in Skamania County, and said lode running in a Northwesterly direction from said creek. Said Souvenir being the property of S.P. White, D. Caples and G.E. Berson parties of thesecond part, do by these presents, exchange grant, sell, bargain and convey unto the said S.P.White, D. Caples and G.E.Beeson parties of the second part, their executors, and assigns all my right, title and interest in the "Kickapoo" Mining quartz claim, said claim being more fully described as follows towit:

Fifteen hundred linear feet of this lode in length with surface ground three hundred feet in width on each side of the center of said lode situated in the Bald Mountain Mining district(unorganized) County of Skamania and State of Washington and known as the "Kickapoo" Mining claim and extending fifteen hundred feet to and from discovery or location notice at shaft. The exterior boundaries of this claim being distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows:

One hundred yards below "triple" falls, also at a fall on Blue Bird Creek-----

then commencing at lode and running three hundred feet in Northeasterly direction to corner stake; thence, fifteen hundred feet in a Southeasterly direction to a corner stake; thence, three hundred feet in a Southwesterly direction to center stake; thence, three hundred feet in same direction to corner stake; thence, fifteen hundred feet in a North westerly direction to corner stake; thence, three hundred feet in a Northeasterly direction to place of beginning. This claim to include all dips, spurs, angles, rights and privileges vested in same.
