All my right, title, and interest in the Blue Bird Grey Eagle and Blue Jacket Mining claim, on Blue Bird creek in Skamania Co. Washington, in Township 3 North range 5 East W.M. located by S.P. White, Douglas Caples and D.C. Greenwalt and recored in Books A and B. Miscellaneous pages ("A" 211) ("B" 18 & 19) respectively, at Court House at Stevenson, Skamania County, Wash.

To have and to hold the same to the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns forever, and I do, for their heirs, executors and administrators, covenant and agree to and with the said parties of the second part to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels thereby made unto the said parties of the second part their executors, administrators and assigns against all and every person and persons-----

whom soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
