

T. E. Inman wife and Wilson, Reed & Co.

This Agreement made and entered into this 8th day of December, 1898 by and between T. E. Inman and Emma Inman (his wife) of Skamania County, Washington, parties of the first part, and Wilson, Reed & Company, of Multnomah County, Oregon, parties of the second part, Witnesseth:

That the said T. E. Inman and Emma Inman (his wife), for and in consideration of One (\$1⁰⁰) Dollar in cash paid, and the further consideration of One (\$1⁰⁰) Dollar per month to be paid monthly by said Wilson, Reed & Company, in fee to allow, and do by this instrument grant, the said Wilson, Reed & Company, the right of way over and through the following-described lands:

Lots Eight (8) and Nine (9), of Section One (1), Township Two (2), North Range Seven (7) East Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, for the purpose of building and constructing a flume for running wood and lumber from their saw-mill; and the said Wilson, Reed & Company shall have the privilege of entering in and upon said lands for the purpose of constructing and repairing said flume; said flume to take the most feasible course, and to be so constructed as to cause as little annoyance and damage as possible to the said parties of the first part.

And it is agreed by and between the parties hereto that whenever the said Wilson, Reed & Company shall quit and cease using said flume it shall remain on the land and become the property of the parties of the first part.

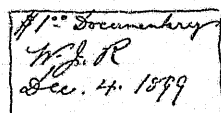
