To have and of hold the same to the said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns forever and I do for his heirs, executors, admistrators and assigns covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part his executors.

adminsitrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of said property goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
