Know all men by these presents, that C. M. Benham & W. S. Barff doing business as Benham & Barff at Carson, Skamania County, Washington the parties of the first part for and consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other baluable consideration to them on hand paid by William Anderson of Portland Oregon the party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns all the following described personal property towit:

All the Fir and Pine logs lying on the bank in the stream and at the mouth of Wind River in Skamania County Washington, heretofore, cut and placed in and alongside of said river by said Benham and Barff amounting to 259,000 feet (more or less).

To have and to hold the same to the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And we do for ourselves heirs executors and administrators covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part his executors, Administrators and assigns to warrant-----

and defend the sale of the said property goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
