

FRANK DAVIS TO L. A. CLARK.

Know all men by these presents that I, Frank Davis the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty five Dollars gold coin of the United States of America to me in hand paid by L. A. Clark the party of the second part the receipt wherof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part executors, administrators and assigns all of the following described personal property to wit:

One hundred Cord of First class cord wood ( four feet long to the stick) said wood to be cut from green timber and said wood to be cut from green timber and said wood is to be delivered on the beach on or before the 15th day of June 1898. Now it is through agreed and understood by and between both parties that the said wood is to be delivered on the beach of the Columbia river on the Washington side in Skamania Co. in convenient and suitable place for boating said wood i.e. in or about Kanackabery landing on the west side of Wind Mountain. The party of the second part to pay the party of the first part \$125.00/100 per cord or---

the ruling price agreed upon at the time of delivery

To have and to hold the same to the said party of second part his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I, do, for my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of said property goods and chattles hereby made unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
