And we do for our heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part its successors and assigns against all and every person and persons whosoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
