

No. 144. Permit to Prospect Mineral Lands

This provisional Lease, License or Permit, made and entered into this 24th day of May, 1899, by and between the State of Washington, and L. J. Moore, of Mt. Pleasant, Wash.

Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars, (\$5.00) paid the Treasurer of the State of Washington, said State of Washington doth license the said L. J. Moore to prospect that tract or parcel of land now belonging to the said State of Washington and said to contain mineral other than coal (but not known to be mineral bearing at the time of survey), Silicate in the County of Skamania, and more particularly described as follows, viz: -

A mining claim 600 x 1500 feet, running in a Southeast and Northwesterly direction, and located in the S. 1/2 of the S.W. 1/4 and the N.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4, as near as may be, and known as the "Golden Rod" claim.

(Public Bldgs. at State Capital grant)
in Section 12, Township 3 N. Range 8 E. N.M., containing 20.64 acres, the same being in Bald Mt. Mining District.

This provisional Lease being granted under the provisions of Chapter C.II. Session Laws of 1897, approved March 17, 1897.
