Know all men by these presents; That I, G.W. Fisher of Skamania County, Washington for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred (\$200.00) Dollars to me in hand paid by Robert Mays, E. C. Pease and W. H. Hobson partners doing business under the firm name and style of Pease and Mays, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and transferred, assigned granted and set over and do by these presents bargain, sell, transfer, assign, convey and set over unto the said Robert Mays, E. C. Pease and W. H. Hobson and to their administrators executors and assigns, forever, all the following described personal property now situated on the wharf at Drano Landing in said Skamania County, Washington now owned by me, to-wit:

About twenty five thousand feet (25,000) of common pine lumber situated in five different piles; Also, 5000 feet more or less of yellow fir lumber, said last mentioned fir lumber being now situated at my saw mill, nine miles from said Drano Landing, an

all of said lumber subject to measurement at the Dalles Oregon.

Said Said first mentioned lumber being all the lumber now owned by me and situated on said wharf being the only wharf at said Drano Unading Washington.

To have and to hold all said above described property unto the said Robert Mays, E.C. Pease and W.H. Hobson and to their administrators executors and assigns forever, and I the said G.W. Fisher, hereby covenant with the said Robert Mays, E.C. Pease and W. H. Hobson and with their administrators executors and assigns that I am the owner of said property and that the same is free from all heirs, incumbrances and charges of any and all kinds whatsoever and that I will forever warrant the tilte and possession of said lumber unto the said Robert Mays, E. C. Pease and W. H. Hobson their adminystrators, executors and assigns forever.
