

No. 15 Permit to Prospect Mineral Lands.

This provisional lease, license or Permit, made and entered into this 24th day of May, 1899, by and between the State of Washington and Wm. E. Jones, of Portland, Ore.,

Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) paid the Treasurer of the State of Washington, said State of Washington doth license the said William E. Jones, to prospect that tract or parcel of land now belonging to the said State of Washington and said to contain minerals other than coal (but not known to be mineral bearing at the time of survey) situate in the county of Skamania, and more particularly described as follows, viz:

1. Mining claim 600 x 1500 ft. beginning at the 1/4 section corner between Secs. 12 and 13, Twp. 3 N., Rg. 5 E. T. 7 N.; thence N. 400 feet; thence N. 7. 580 feet to the northwest corner end; thence N. 2. 300 ft.; thence S. 2. 1500 feet; thence S. 7. 600 ft.; thence N. 7. 1500 ft.; thence N. 7. 300 ft. to point of beginning, the same being in the Public Lands at State Capital grant, and known as the "Golden Hill" claim. in said sections 12 and 13, Township 3. N., Range 5. E. T. 7 N., containing 25/64 acres, the same being in Bald Mt. Mining District.

This provisional lease being granted under the provisions of Chapter CII, Session Laws of 1897, approved March 17, 1897.
