Full consideration for timber and such rights of way across said land as may be needed for Logging Roads, Flumes, Ditches etc. One hundred and Fifty Dollars. One hundred Dollars to me in hand paid and the receipt I hereby acknowledged.

If within a period of Twenty Four Months from the date of this instrument said Oregon Lumber Company may conclude that they do not desire timber and right of way as covered by this Bill of Sale, I agree to refund them with interest the One Hundred Dollars received herein.

Provided however: That said Luber Company give me sixty days notice in case refund is desired . In the event of said Oregon Lumber Company desiring Timber and right of way as herein mentioned they an theirs, provided the sum coming Fifty Dollars is paid me with in-----

the time specified as to refund Twenty -Four Months.
