

No. 49 . . . Permit to Prospect Mineral Lands

This Provisional Lease, License & Permit, made and entered into this 13th day of November, 1899, by and between the State of Washington and C. P. Bush of Vercennes, Wash.

Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) paid the Treasurer of the State of Washington, said State of Washington doth license the said C. P. Bush to prospect that tract or parcel of land now belonging to the said State of Washington and said to contain mineral other than coal (but not known to be mineral bearing at the time of survey) situate in the county of . . . and more particularly described as follows, viz:

Commencing at a point due southwest 40 rods from the quarter stake of the east line of Sec. 13, Twp. 3 N., Rg. 5 E. T. 1 N., running thence in a north westerly direction 1500 ft., thence southeasterly 600 ft., thence southeasterly 1500 ft., thence northwesterly 600 ft. to the place of beginning (the west or north end connecting with the Gold Standard claim)

"Sixteen to One."

in Section 13, Township 3 N., Range 5 E. T. 1 N., containing 20.66 acres the same being in the Bald Mt. Mining District
