Miller, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns all of the following described personal property, to wit:

All of the one third (1/3) each of the undivided mining claims Recorded and known as "Monteray and Canyon Creek" Mining Claims in Skamania County Washington in the Copper Creek Mining District.

To have and to hold, the same to the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, forever: And I do for myself, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his ~~XXX~~ executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of said property, goods and chattel thereby made unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or-----

to claim the same.
