BILL OF SALE.

Know all men by these presents, that for and in consideration of One Hundred & Seven 76/100 Dollars to me in hand paid by L. D. Stockhouse of Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington I do hereby bargain, sell and make over to L.D. Stockhouse the following described personal property, to wit:

Five (5) Peeveys, Six (6) Double bitted Axes, Three (3) shovels, One (1) cross cut saw, One (1) sledge One (1) wedge, Four hundred (400) feet cable, Thirty three (33) sacks of Barley and Thirty Four (34) bales hay, the property of Bixby and Moody, now on the premises of L. D. Stockhouse and Twelve (12) boom chains and fourteen (14) boom sticks now on the right bank of the Columbia River on the homestead of Jeff Nix, the property of Bixby and Moody. To have and to hold the same free of all incumbrances against the lawful claim of any person or persons whomsoever.
