Know all men by these presents, that I, E. Engelson of Washougal Clarke County State of Washington the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars Gold coin of the United States of America, to me in hand paid by Egerd Nagel of Washougal Clarke County, State of Washington the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, all of the following described personal property, to-wit:

All of The Solomon Quartz Lode Mining Claim extending along said Lode or Vein 1500 feet in a N. Westerly direction from the center of the Discovery or Tunnel at which tunnel this notice and statement is posted and 300 feet on each side from the middle or center of said Lode or vein at the surface, comprising in all 1500 feet in length containing Twenty (20) Acres all situated in the Ball Mountain Mining District Skamania County, Washington.

To have and to hold the same so the said party of the second part, there executors, administrators and assigns forever.
