B. Williams of Multnomah County, Oregon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell assign, transfer and set over to C. B. Williams all our right, title, and claim in and to those certain water rights acquired by said Felix G. Iman under the laws of the state of Washington, upon Rock Creek in said Skamania County, Washington and recorded in Vol. "D" at page 140, of the miscellaneous Records of Skamania County State of Washington on the 15th day of May 1899 for the details of which said water rights the terms and conditions thereof reference is hereby made to said book and page of said records which are hereby made a part of this instrument: Also all our right, title and interest in and to all dams on Rock Creek, owned by us and in which we have any claim or interest. Together with all our interest in and to the contracts and rights given to C.C. Wilson and Annie Wilson, his wife, under contract made with Felix C. Iman for the construction of a dam on Rock Creek and of a flume between said dam and the Columbia River, said contract being of date

April 19, 1899.

To have and ot hold to the said C. B. Williams his heirs, assigns and successors in interest forever.
