

Geo H. Nicolai to Over H. Hamre.

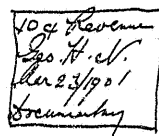
In consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Twenty-eight (328) Dollars cash by me in hand paid by Over H. Hamre of Underwood Precinct, County of Skamania and State of Washington, being the amount of borrowed money of a loan made by me to said Hamre on the 26th day of May, A. D., 1899, and in order to secure which a certain Timber Deed was executed of even date by said Over H. Hamre in my favor, acknowledged the same day, before Carlos W. Shane, a Notary Public for the State of Washington at Vancouver, Washington, and recorded in the Records of Skamania County, State of Washington, on the 29th day of July A. D., 1899, in Book 1 of Agreements at page 75; - upon all the merchantable timber standing, or being on the west half of the North West quarter and the west half of the South West quarter of Section nine in Township Three north range ten east Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington; and as further evidence of said indebtedness said Hamre then executed and delivered to me his certain promissory note for the sum of Fifty Dollars; - I do now declare said debt fully paid and discharged, and do hereby satisfy and discharge said Timber Contract above referred to, and the Auditor of Skamania County aforesaid, will please enter satisfaction on the margin of the record thereof; and I do declare said promissory note for \$50.00 and interest paid off and discharged, but said note is lost or mislaid, and cannot be found, and I hereby bind myself by these presents to re-imburse said Hamre for any loss or damage that might at any time come to him by virtue of said note getting into any innocent third party's hands, this obligation as to said note to be void should said note be found and delivered cancelled to said Hamre, or his attorney, John Leland Henderson.
