Permit to Prospect Mineral Lands.

This provisional Lease, License or Permit, made and entered into this 5th day of December, 1900, by and between the State of Washington and David W. Hutchinson of Skye, Wash.

Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) paid the Treasurer of the State of Washington, said State of Washington doth license the said David W. Hutchinson to prospect that tract or parcel of land now belonging to the said State of Washington and said to contain mineral other than coal (but not known to be mineral bearing at the time of survey), situated in the County of Skamania, and more particularly described as follows, viz:

Beginning at Discovery Shaft, which point is 1320 ft. E. of the N.W. corner of Sec. 14, Twp. 3 N., Rg. 5 E. T. 11 N., and running thence N. 60° E. 300 ft; thence N. 30° W. 1000 ft; thence S. 60° W. 600 ft; thence S. 3° E. 1000 ft; and thence N. 60° E. 300 ft to place of beginning, being in in Section 11, Township 3 N., Range 5 E. T. 11 N., containing 20.60 acres, the same being in Bald Mountain District, and being known as the "Twin Baby" claim.

This provisional Lease being granted under the provisions of Chapter C11, Session Laws of 1897, approved March, 17, 1897.
