BILL OF SALE.

This to certify that I have this day sold to Oregon Lumber Company all timber on my Homestead NO. 8365 State of Washington, County of Skamania Township 3, N. Range 9 East. Also the timber on the Shaw Homestead NO. 9764, same State, County, Township and Range I grant to said Oregon Lumber Company the right to build and operate such road or roads as may be necessary to get timber to their Mills or Mills.

The timber on lands as above described is to be removed within a period of (4) four years. The said Oregon Lumber Company are to have the use of the house on the Shaw Homestead for an period of one year from the date of this instrument and the use of the house on the Cook Homestead, during whatever period is required to remove timber, covered by this bill of sale. Full consideration for timber and privileges as heretofore mentioned or described is Six Thousand Dollars to be paid on or before May 1st, 1900. Last payment mentioned is to be secured by promissory note, which is to draw no interest. Dated at Viento, Oregon this 6th day of February, 1900.
