

F. L. Swan with J. L. & W. A. Gates.

This agreement entered into on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 1901, between F. L. Swan of the first part and J. L. Gates and W. A. Gates parties of the second part; Witnesseth that party of the first part agrees to let parties of the second part have the use of a certain skid & logging road now on the land of the party known as the Vaughanman Donation Land Claim, said road being the road partly built and used by Swan Dale Co. said party of the first part reserves the right to use said road himself at any time when necessary for logging purposes.

The parties of the second part agree to pay the party of the first part at the rate of ten cents per thousand feet for all the logs that they haul over said road, and to keep said road in good repair and at the expiration of this agreement to leave the road in as good repair as at the present time reasonable wear excepted.

This agreement shall continue in force for a period of two years from date.

It is further agreed if the parties of the second part are not through with their logging at that time this agreement shall continue in force one year longer.
