

E. G. STONE TO JOHN W. THOMPSON.

Know all men by these presents, that I, E.G. Stone of Stevenson County of Skamania, State of Washington, party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty five Dollars, to me in hand paid by John W. Thompson party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, sold, transferred and delivered and by these presents do grant, sell transfer and deliver unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns the following described personal property to wit:

Forty cords or less of fir wood now on the J. H. Handrub Homestead near Nelson Creek Flume in Skamania County, Washington. The same being all the cordwood made by me on that place.

To have and to hold said above described property to the said party of the second part his executors, administrators, and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part his executors, administrators and assigns, do hereby covenant to and with the party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, that said property is free from all incumbrances and will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
