Know all men by these presents that Henry Turner of Stevenson, County of Skamania, State of Wash. party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar per cord or Three hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by John W. Thompson party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, sold, transferred and delivered and by these presents do grant, sell, transfer and deliver unto the said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns, the following described personal property, to wit:

Three hundred cords of fir wood now on the Henry Turner homestead in Skamania County, State of Washington.

To have and to hold said above described property to the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part, his executors, administrators and assigns, do hereby covenant to and with the party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, that said property is free from all incumbrances and will warrant and defend of all persons whomever.
