Wilson, party of the second part, do by these presence, grant, bargain, sell and convey to said said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns: One Brown horse eight years old with some white on one hind foot and small white spot on forehead, and weighing about 1150 pounds, and named "Dan", and also one bay mare seven years old, blind in right eye, and with a small white spot in forehead, and weighing about 1150 pounds, and named "Moll" and also one double set of harness with rope tugs, all of which property is now situate on said first parties premises in Skamania County, Washington.

To have and to hold the same to the said party of the second part his, executors and assigns forever.

And I do for myself and my heirs, executors, and administrators, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of the said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and

assigns against all and every person and persons who-
soever lawfully claiming or to claim.
