This is to certify that I have this day sold to Jas. T. Peters all my right, title and interest, in and to the Collins Creek Flume, situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, being the same as empties on the North Bank of the Columbia River, near Collins Landing in the said County and State, together with all water rights and other privileges in any way connected with the said flume, including right of way and the water rights to the water which flows into the large lake which supplies the said flume with water with which to operate the flume for the sum of none dollar and other valuable considerations.

This is intended to convey and transfer a full one half interest in the flume above described,
