Know all men by these presents that I Tennis Wyers the part of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars, Gold coin of the United States of America, to me in hand paid by Job Angell & G. Cline the parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, bargain sell, and convey unto the said parties of the second part their executors, administrators and assigns all of the folowin described personal property, towit: The undivided one half interest in the "Number Five" mining claim, in the Mt. Adams Mining District County of Skamania State of Washington, and described on the Notice of Location as follows: Commencing at blazed fir tree on the East bank of the West fork of Lewis River, thence, running Easterly 1500 ft. to stake, ablated fir tree 4 ft. west, thence, Northerly 600 ft. to stake, ablated fir tree 9 ft. east, thence, Westerly 1500 ft. to stake on East bank of said stream, Thence, Southerly 600 ft. down stream to place of beginning. Bounded on the South by Job Angell's and G. L. Cline's Claim and on the North by Ewin B. Angell's Claim.
