The grantors, Hans J. Lillegard and Carrie Lillegard, his wife of Stevenson, Wash., for and in consideration of one inch galvanized iron pipe to be laid from main pipe to their residence and to be furnished water free as long as pipe line exists: Do hereby let and lease to John T. Totten of Stevenson, Wash. the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit: A right of way for a pipe line to convey water to Stevenson, through Lot 2 Section 36 Township N^o 3 North Range 7 East W. M. with the understanding that the said John T. Totten furnish grass seed to seed the ground dug up in laying said pipe line, and furthermore to pay any reasonable damage that may be caused by said leaks or bursts in said pipe line or by repairing said pipe line; said pipe line to be laid eighteen inches below the surface of the ground. This right of way to exist as long as the pipe line lasts that is now to be laid. Dated this 12. Day of January, 1904.
