Michell, of the first part and David Nevels, of the second part, both of the County of Skamania and State of Washington, witnesseth: That in consideration of stipulations herein contained and the payments to be made as hereinafter specified, the party of the first part hereby agrees to sell unto the party of the second part the following described real property, situated in the County of Skamania, and State of Washington, more particularly known and described as commencing at the N.W. corner of S.
